The Øresund Bridge

Øresundsbro Konsortiet is a Danish-Swedish company jointly owned by the Danish and Swedish states. It owns and runs the Øresund Bridge between Denmark and Sweden. The bridge opened on 1 July 2000.

The Øresund Bridge consists of i) the Øresund tunnel between Amager (at Kastrup south of Copenhagen), ii) the artificial island Peberholm (south of Salt Holm), iii) and the Øresund Bridge – a combined girder and cable-stayed bridge between Peberholm and Lernacken (south of Malmö) in Scania. The connection consists of a highway and a double railroad tracks. Total length is 15.9 km.

The bridge makes a safe and effective link for people commuting between Denmark and Sweden.
